PROCEDURE FOR JOINING HRVATSKI KLUB BELGIJSKIH OVČARA (HKBO)

To submit a request to join HKBO it is necessary to read the HKBO Statute which can be found on the official HKBO website www.hkbo.hr and to fill out the **Application for Membership form** (for individuals who do not have permanent or temporary residence in the Republic of Croatia) and send it, together with all required documentation, to the HKBO email address: hkbo@hkbo.hr

We kindly note that you should carefully review the **Application for Membership form** (for individuals who do not have permanent or temporary residence in the Republic of Croatia) and then, if you wish, complete it.

In the **Application for Membership form** (for individuals who do not have permanent or temporary residence in the Republic of Croatia), it is necessary to mark the type of membership fee with an X next to the type of HKBO membership fee (regular or supporting) that you want to pay for the current year.

Your personal data (name, surname and country) will be published for inspection by all HKBO members on the official HKBO website www.hkbo.hr. Membership is possible if, within 30 days, no objection is submitted by any HKBO member. Written objections must be sent to the HKBO email hkbo@hkbo.hr or to the secretary of the HKBO within the specified period of 30 days. In the case of a reasoned objection, the Presidency decides on admission to membership.

If you do not send all required documentation along with the completed **Application for Membership form** (for individuals who do not have permanent or temporary residence in the Republic of Croatia), your data will not be published on the official HKBO website until you do so.

After the required conditions have been met, we will send an e-mail letter and payment details for paying the membership fee for a new HKBO member to your e-mail address. If you do not meet the requirements, we will also notify you in writing to the e-mail address you entered in the **Application for Membership form** (for individuals who do not have permanent or temporary residence in the Republic of Croatia). You become an HKBO member upon meeting the required conditions in accordance with the HKBO Statute, paying the membership fee for a new HKBO member, and being entered in the Register of Members maintained by the HKBO secretary.
